DIAL-A-TAXI

Transfort offers subsidies for your taxi trips through a voucher program. These trips are like any ordinary taxi ride, providing door-to-door service, yet will cost less because of the subsidy. The Dial-A-Taxi program is operated by zTRIP; wheelchair accessible vans are available. Trips are subject to availability by the taxicab operator.

Funding is provided by Transfort through a grant from the Federal Transit Administration.

Trips must originate within the Dial-A-Ride (DAR) Service Area (see map on reverse side) but can end anywhere. Return trips must have an origin trip, and must end within this area. Taxi fares apply after the subsidized limit is reached; passengers are responsible for the balance of the trip's expense. All reservations and payments are made with zTRIP. Requests can be made up to 24 hours in advance of the trip.

FARES

\$2.50 per one-way trip, plus any fares for trips that cost over a \$20 taximeter. Transfort covers \$17.50 of any trip. Caregivers accompanying DAR clients ride free. Fees are paid directly to the taxi cab operator via cash or authorized credit card.

Dial-A-Taxi is a flexible option for DAR clients who need last-minute trips anywhere the passenger wants to go. There are no restrictions on the destination; however, passengers would have to pay \$2.50 plus any fare above the \$20 taximeter.
