



HOW TO PURCHASE PASSFORTS

- 1 Employers purchase PassFort vouchers from a Transit Center. Vouchers never expire, allowing employers the option to hold vouchers until needed.
- 2 The employee takes the voucher to a Transit Center and trades it in for an annual pass.

PURCHASE PASSFORTS AT ONE OF THREE TRANSIT CENTERS:

- ▶ **Downtown Transit Center**

- ▶ **Colorado State University Transit Center**
Lory Student Center, north end (closed during summer)
- ▶ **South Transit Center**

EMPLOYER COST OPTIONS

- ▶ Cover the entire cost of passes for employees,
- ▶ Have employees reimburse the employer for the cost of the pass or,
- ▶ Share the expense of the passes between employer and employee.

MEMBERS OF BUSINESS ASSOCIATIONS

Members of business organizations (currently the Chamber of Commerce and the Downtown Business Association—check ridetransfort.com for updates) can purchase passes at the organization's administrative offices (a small administrative fee applies).

PASSFORT BUS PASS PROGRAM

PassFort is a bus pass program that enables employers to purchase “bulk rate” annual Transfort bus passes for their employees. PassFort is available to all employers in Fort Collins regardless of the size of the company.

PassFort helps businesses provide a sustainable and economical transportation option for their employees, and helps address parking, air quality, and congestion issues.

Passes are valid for all Transfort fixed route services, including MAX bus rapid transit and FLEX regional service (exception: Green & Gold late night service).

IRS COMMUTER BENEFITS

To offset the cost of transit passes, companies can take advantage of a tax-free employer-paid benefit, pre-tax employee-paid payroll deduction, or a combination of up to \$130 per employee per month.

ANNUAL COST: \$50 PER PASS

Participating businesses receive a bulk rate of \$50 per pass. That's a 68% savings compared to a regular adult annual pass (\$154). Minimum purchase requirements apply:

- ▶ For businesses over 25 employees, a business must purchase at least 25 passes.
- ▶ For businesses of less than 25 employees, a business must purchase a pass for every employee.

TRANSFORT FAST FACTS

- ▶ Transfort operates 21 bus routes.
- ▶ MAX bus rapid transit is a service of Transfort (Free WiFi service).
- ▶ FLEX regional service connects Longmont, Berthoud, Loveland, and Fort Collins (Free WiFi service).
- ▶ There are nearly 500 bus stops in Fort Collins.
- ▶ Bus service operates year-round, Monday–Saturday.
- ▶ All buses are equipped with bike racks that carry up to 3 bicycles (4 on MAX).
- ▶ All Transfort buses are wheelchair accessible.
